SCORING INSTRUCTIONS: The **RED** numbers are Points earned based on a 10-1 scale in each of (12) data point categories; 10 points going to the 1st (most) place scaling down to 1 point to the 10th place within each of the (12) different data categories; then accumulated points are added for a school score  
 CAMP Grants that accumulate the most points typically hold larger blood drives, do more than one day, surpass their own set goals, have the majority of their CAMPer campus community participate, and successfully report complete results data on time.
